

Information about the 4 week summer practice (4th year) at the Dep. of Transplantation and Surgery

The surgical practice consists of four consecutive weeks to be completed in two periods: July or August, overlapping or shifting is not possible. The exact dates depend on the current year, starting always on Monday.

Registration is possible via the Neptun system.

The work time is 35h/week on workdays and each student must complete two night shifts during the period.

Each day starts at 7.30 with the ward rounds following by the medical conference and then the operative program. No absence is accepted.

White clothes will be provided, students are required to have their own shoes for internal use.

Due to the limited number of patients, medical staff, teachers and operations in the summer period, we do accept only a very limited number of medical students, see Neptun.
